

## New Jersey Environmental Infrastructure Financing Program Project No. S340640-35

Construction of upgrades and improvements to the CCMUA's Sludge Dewatering Conveyance System, with a capital cost of \$3,500,000 were financed by the New Jersey Water Bank (NJWB). The NJWB is a State Revolving Fund program jointly administered by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) and the New Jersev Infrastructure Bank (NJIB) and a combination uses of funds provided by the United States Environmental Protection Agency, the DEP, and the NJIB to provide very low interest loans to borrowers for environmental infrastructure projects.

This project will provide water quality benefits by improving the reliability and efficiency of the treatment equipment, and in turn ensuring exceptional environmental performance and social benefits for residents and businesses in Camden County, New Jersey.
